<p>Church Hall. 1914. Red brick and plain clay tile. Hall and attached 2-storey 'Church House' forming 'L' plan. Red brick in English bond with large stepped brick buttresses, angled entrance doorway with modern double timber and glazed doors set in four-centred arched doorway. Hipped dormers with clay tile roofs and clay tile hanging. Clay tile hanging to gable of Church House. Windows timber casements, those to the hall 8-pane with arched head. 2 light casements with leaded panes to dormers. South gable four-centred arch doorway and dentil pattern stringcourse.</p> <p>Forms group with Church (also Locally Listed).</p>
