<p>Shop and offices. C1890s. Red brick with ashlar and timber shopfront, parapet conceals slate roof. 3-storey corner building, gable to Station Road. Red brick in Flemish bond with pilasters to each floor with moulded brick stringcourses between floors and dentilled cornice. Ground floor has late 20th century replacement shopfront with panelled door with fanlight to upper floors in Station Road facade. First floor windows with stone mullion and transoms with uPVC casements. Curved corner with advertisement. Second floor horned timber sashes without glazing bars and moulded terracotta architraves, window to gable has swept rubbed brick heads flanking small central light with flat gauged brick arch above. Cast iron downpipes.</p>
