<p>Bank premises. 1881. Red brick and terracotta; roof obscured by parapet. 3-storey. Corner building. Chamfered corner at ground floor level with oversize projecting moulding taking the corner over first and second floor. Red brick in Flemish bond with moulded brick stringcourses and decorative terracotta panels between first and second floor levels. Simple doorway with bullnose brick jambs to Gordon Road, principal doorway to Victoria Road with classical terracotta doorcase comprising fluted pilasters with inset Corinthian pilasters, scrolled corbels supporting pediment with central roundel bearing the date 1881. Ground floor windows are timber casements, first floor windows narrow horned vertical sliding timber sashes, the top sash with margin lights. Second floor windows, smaller but also horned vertical sliding sashes with margin lights. All windows recessed with flat gauged brick arches with raised pink ashlar keystones. Parapet with central pediment (bearing inscription 'Established 1834') flanked by two ball finials to Victoria Road (west missing its ball), 2 gables to Gordon Road, one with the remains of a chimney stack with the stack removed above roofline.</p>

Historical Context: Historic bank on Bank Corner – On the corners of Wellington Street, Victoria Road and Gordon Road stood 3 banks – Lloyds, Westminster and National Provincial. Built on the site of a farmyard which adjoined the Victoria Hotel. The inscription established 1834 refers to the old Capital and Counties Bank which was taken over in Aldershot by Lloyds in 1914.
