<p>Pair of detached houses. 1899. Red brick in Flemish bond and ashlar with slate roof. Houses have mirror plans. Each house; 2-storey, 3-bays. Central doorway in projecting gabled porch with glazed and timber panel door flanked by casement windows with diamond motif above and mock timber-frame gable. Porch flanked by double height square plan projecting gabled bay to side. Ground floor windows are horned vertical sliding sashes without glazing bars set in ashlar surrounds with shouldered heads. First floor windows similar with the addition of a large opening with 2-over-1 pane sash. Red brick end stacks. Clay ridge tiles and finials. Bracketed eaves. Both houses with name plaques and dates. Both have front garden replacement brick boundary walls in stretcher bond. A remarkably intact pair of late Victorian houses.</p>
