Historical Context:

Church for South Farnborough. July 1880 foundation stone laid by Duchess of Connaught. Original design for a tower and the base was constructed in 1889 but the tower and spire was never built.

The intention was to build the church, a house for the curate and a school on the site. The school was eventually built in Queen's Road.

This building is included on the List of Buildings of Local Significance due to its high historic, aesthetic and community values.
