<p>Former lodge. c1890s. Red brick and buff brick with natural slate roof. Single storey, irregular plan. Red brick in Flemish bond. South elevation has central doorway with red brick Gothic arch set in projecting gabled porch with glazed and timber door with buff brick detailing. This is flanked by timber-framed vertical sliding sashes without glazing bars with buff brick surrounds and red gauged brick arches. North elevation comprises two gables formed from parallel ranges with valley gutter between. Large red brick ridge stack to rear range. Pierced decorative bargeboards to gables. Modern brick wall boundary.</p>

Historical Context:

The lodge first appears on the OS1897 map (1:2500). It is set on the end of a long winding drive which leads north to a large house; Knellwood which still survives today as Knellwood War Memorial Home. The latter has been much altered and extended.

Despite some changes, the lodge still retains its essential form and character and therefore is included on the List of Buildings of Local Significance due to its high historic and aesthetic values.
