<p>Public House. Mid 19th century and later. Rendered with natural slate roof and rendered stacks. 2-storey with later single-storey gabled flanking ranges with canted bays. Main façade 4 windows, a double-height canted bay and further two windows, one blind. Ground floor rusticated. Windows and doors set under plastered arched openings. Ground floor 6-light timber casements. First floor timber vertical sliding sashes with margin lights under cambered arches. Single storey coach house range to north, now connected to the main building; red brick and render with gabled loft opening. An important local landmark.</p>
