<p>Detached house. 1880s-90s. Queen Anne Revival. Red brick with clay tile roof. 2-storey plus attic, rectangular plan with symmetrical facade of 5 windows and central entrance. Red brick in Flemish bond with raised red brick quoins. Central entrance with panelled door with flat gauged brick arch and decorative barrel hood above supported on carved brackets. Entrance door flanked by decorative geometric pattern oxeye windows. Ground floor windows 6-over-6 pane timber vertical sliding sashes with cambered brick arches. First floor windows 6-over-6 sashes with flat gauged brick arches of rubbed brick. Modillions to eaves. Hipped, swept clay tile roof with tall red brick end stacks. Central pedimented 2-light casement dormer flanked either side by segmental pediment dormers. Low single-storey range on west elevation, a later addition.</p>
