The Farnborough Hill estate was sold in 1819 to Mrs Mary Foreman who built a lodge for her nephew, Edward Greene called The Pavilion. Greene served in the Royal Artillery and on retirement moved to live in Farnborough in 1819. Greene supported the welfare of children in Farnborough and Cove erecting a school called The Oaks and later two other schools; The Beeches and Greencroft. The Pavilion, today known as The Lodge is divided into small units and sits in a modern housing estate called Victoria Court. The surrounding estate woodland was purchased by the council in the 1950s and is now the Queen Elizabeth Park.

This building is included on the List of Buildings of Local Significance due to its high evidential, historic and aesthetic values.
