Historical Context:

The Sycamore Estate was constructed initially in the mid 1860's and considerably extended in the following century. Its historical significance is valued through the list of previous occupants, notably housing two army generals; firstly, Sir Thomas Westropp McMahon from 1871 to 1892, who served in Turkey and the Crimea, and was made General of the British Army in 1880, and secondly General Sir Reginald Gipps who also served in the Crimean War. The Sycamore Estate was pulled down in 1979 and the Old White Lodge is all that remains from its original state.

The building was part of the Sycamore Estate and served as a lodge for the Sycamores, a large mansion constructed in the 19th century. The Lodge had extension work done in the 1930s by local builder H.H Hilder (a company remains active in the area), converting it from a lodge into a two-storey house. In the years before the renovation work was done, the estate was being used as a nunnery, merging with the Hillside Convent College set up in the late 19th century. The building has been well maintained and has kept a lot of the original character despite requiring multiple

renovations in recent years. The extension work has clearly been completed with the original build in mind and has kept its traditional feel.
