- (1) The supply of alcohol to members and bona fide guests;
- (2) The provision of regulated entertainment by way of the performance of plays (indoors only);
- (3) The provision of regulated entertainment by way of the exhibition of film(s) (limited to video entertainment on television screens and amusement machines only), (indoors only);
- (4) The provision of regulated entertainment by way of indoor sporting events (limited to the playing of pub games only);
- (5) The provision of regulated entertainment by way of live music (including Karaoke), (indoors only);
- (6) The provision of regulated entertainment by way of recorded music (including jukebox and other sound systems), (indoors only);

- (7) The provision of regulated entertainment by way of the performance of dance (indoors only);
- (8) The provision of regulated entertainments of a similar description to that falling within (5), (6) and (7) above (including pub quizzes, pub games, compere and amplified voice), (indoors only);
- (9) The provision of entertainment facilities for making music (limited to amplification and karaoke equipment), (indoors only); and
- (10) The provision of entertainment facilities for dancing, (indoors only).

  - Sunday's – 10:00am to 24:00midnight;
  - Monday's to Thursday's – 10:00am to 00:30am the following day;

  - On Christmas Eve and New Years Eve – 10:00am to 03:00am the following day.
- (2) The provision of regulated entertainment by way of the performance of plays:-
  - Saturday's and Sunday's only – 14:00pm to 17:00pm
- (3) The provision of regulated entertainment by way of the exhibition of film(s) and/or the provision of indoor sporting events:-
  - Sunday's – 07:00am to 24:00midnight;
  - Monday's to Thursday's – 07:00am to 01:00am the following day;
  - Friday's and Saturday's – 07:00am to 02:00am the following day; and
  - On Christmas Eve and New Years Eve – 10:00am to 03:00am the following day.
- (4) All other qualifying club activities:-
  - Sunday's – 10:00am to 23:30pm;
  - Monday's to Thursday's – 10:00am to 24:00midnight;
  - Friday's and Saturday's – 10:00am to 01:00am the following day; and
  - On Christmas Eve and New Years Eve – 10:00am to 03:00am the following day.

**Annex 1 – Mandatory conditions**

- (1)
  - (i) In respect of the exhibition of films, the admission of children (i.e. anyone aged under 18) must be restricted in accordance with any recommendation(s) made by the film classification body specified (as designated by S4 of the Video Recordings Act 1984 - the British Board of Film Classification).
  - (ii) Where a film classification body is not specified, the admission of children must be restricted in accordance with any recommendation(s) made by the licensing authority.

**Annex 2 – Conditions consistent with the club Operating Schedule**

- (1) Qualifying club activities shall not be undertaken except during permitted hours.
- (2) Notwithstanding the permitted hours, the opening hours of the premises shall be advertised as 11:00am to 23:00pm, whereon, the club secretary may subsequently use his discretion to allow qualifying club activities for the remainder of the permitted hours.
- (3) The premises shall remain open for a minimum of 30 minutes following the last sale / supply of alcohol during permitted hours. This period may be used for drinking-up and the use of lavatories only.
- (4) A member of the committee shall actively participate in any local Pubwatch scheme.
- (5) Non-members of the club shall not be permitted entry into the premises after 22:00pm, unless accompanied by a member of the club.
- (6) A prominent and clear notice outlining the clubs policy regarding drug taking and/or the presence of drugs on the premises shall be provided at a suitable location where it may easily be read by persons admitted thereon.
- (7) No person who is or appears to be intoxicated shall be sold alcohol.
- (8)
  - (i) Regular noise assessments of the area adjacent to the premises shall be undertaken whilst qualifying club activities are taking place.
  - (ii) Where necessary to prevent public nuisance, suitable and sufficient steps should be taken to reduce noise / sound levels from the premises.
- (9) No child(ren) under the age of 18 are permitted to enter or remain on the premises at any time unless accompanied by a member of the club.
- (10) No one under the age of 18 is permitted to enter or remain on the premises during the provision of any form of cabaret-style entertainment.

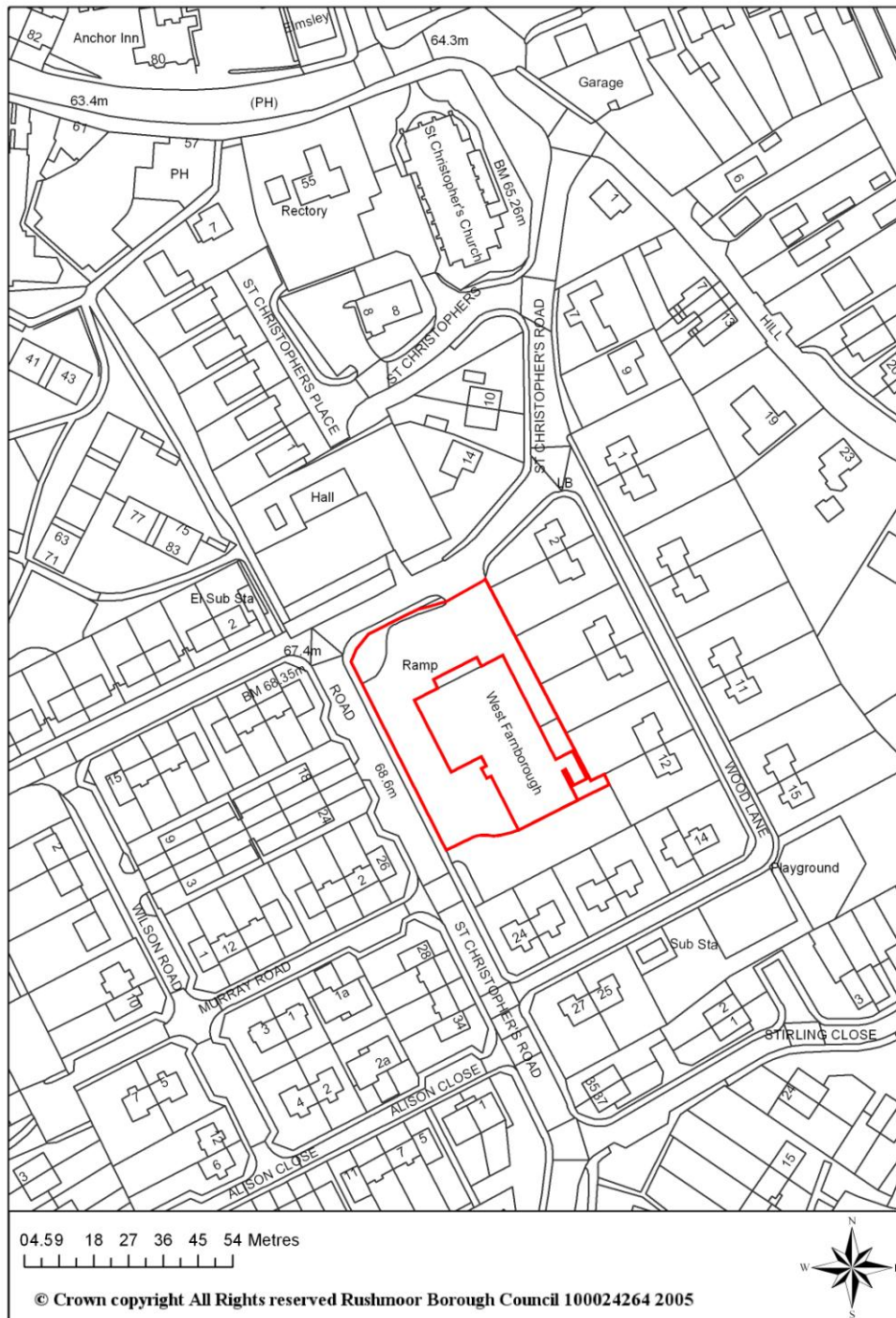
**Annex 3 – Conditions attached after a hearing by the licensing authority**

- (1) Except for access and egress, all external doors and windows of the premises must be closed and kept closed between 21:00pm and the end of opening hours on any day.
- (2) Except for access and egress, all external areas of the club premises shall be closed to members, guests and members of the public and remain closed (i.e. vacated) so far as is reasonably practicable between 21:00pm and the end of the opening hours on any day.
- (3) Suitable and sufficient notices shall be located at all exits of the premises (including car park) requesting patrons to leave the premises and area quietly, to refrain from slamming car doors or causing any disturbance that may cause offence to neighbours.
- (4) Suitable and sufficient supplies of first aid equipment / materials must be made available to members of the public on request. Dependant on the activities, events and risks at the premises, a suitably trained first aider or an appointed person for first aid must also be present on the premises at all times during licensable activities.
