- (7) The provision of regulated entertainment by way of anything of a similar description to that falling within (4), (5) and (6) above (including games, quizzes etc), (indoors only);
- (8) The provision of entertainment facilities for making music (indoors only); and
- (9) The provision of entertainment facilities for dancing (indoors only).

- (1) The supply of alcohol to members and bona fide guests:-
  - Sunday's 07:00am to 24:00midnight; and
  - Monday to Saturday 07:00am to 02:00am the following day.
- (2) The provision of regulated entertainment by way of the exhibition of film(s):-
  - Sunday's 07:00am to 24:00midnight; and
  - Monday to Saturday 07:00am to 02:00am the following day.
- (3) The provision of regulated entertainment by way of indoor sporting events and/or live music (including Karaoke) on any day 19:00pm to 24:00midnight.
- (4) The provision of regulated entertainment by way of recorded music:-
  - Sunday to Thursday 10:00am to 24:00midnight; and
  - Friday's and Saturday's 10:00am to 01:30am the following day.
- (5) The provision of regulated entertainment by way of the performance of dance, by way of anything of a similar description to live and recorded music or the performance of dance, the provision of facilities for dancing and /or making music:-
  - Sunday to Thursday 19:00pm to 24:00midnight; and
  - Friday's and Saturday's 19:00pm to 01:30am the following day.

#### **Annex 1 – Mandatory conditions**

- (1) (i) The supply of any alcohol for consumption off the premises must be made at a time when the premises are open for the purposes of supplying alcohol, in accordance with the club premises certificate, to members of the club for consumption on the premises.
  - (ii) Any alcohol supplied for consumption off the premises must be in a sealed container.
- (2) Any alcohol supplied for consumption off the premises must be made to a member of the club in person.
- (3) (i) In respect of the exhibition of films, the admission of children (i.e. anyone aged under 18) must be restricted in accordance with any recommendation(s) made by the film classification body specified (as designated by S4 of the Video Recordings Act 1984 the British Board of Film Classification).
  - (ii) Where a film classification body is not specified, the admission of children must be restricted in accordance with any recommendation(s) made by the licensing authority.



#### Annex 2 – Conditions consistent with the club Operating Schedule

- (1) No qualifying club activities shall be undertaken except during permitted hours.
- (2) A member of the club committee shall be present to supervise the premises and the activities carried on there at any time when qualifying club activities are undertaken.
- (3) Notwithstanding any rules of the club, bona fide guests of members shall not be admitted to the premises at any time between 22:00pm and the end of opening hours on any day.
- (4) The committee of club, and the employees thereof, shall ensure that no person who is or appears to be intoxicated, or who behaves in a disorderly manner, is served alcohol.
- (5) No functions comprising birthday parties and/or similar shall be held at the premises.
- (6) Where the operation of the premises may affect local neighbours, a representative of the premises shall liaise with and attempt to resolve any reasonable concerns of said neighbours as may be appropriate.
- (7) Except for access and egress, all external doors and windows of the premises must be closed and kept closed between 22:00pm and the end of opening hours on any day.
- (8) (i) No music or speech shall be relayed via external speakers other than for events with the prior approval of the licensing authority.
  - (ii) All speakers and amplification equipment shall be kept within the premises and shall not be positioned near to or otherwise facing openings such as doors or windows.
  - (iii) All speakers and amplification equipment shall be placed on suitable anti-vibration mounts.
- (9) Prominent, clear and legible notices shall be displayed at all exit doors requesting patrons and staff to leave the premises and area quietly. Staff shall verbally re-iterate this message to patrons as members and guests leave.
- (10) (i) The licence holder or a nominated representative shall carry out a regular noise assessment of the area adjacent to the premises whilst qualifying club activities are taking place.



- (ii) Such assessments shall take place on all sides of the premises at the boundary of the nearest residential premises, and if audible, steps shall be taken to reduce noise from the premises to a level where noise is no longer audible at the monitoring points.
- (iii) These assessments shall be undertaken at hourly intervals between 22:00pm and the end of the opening hours on any day.
- (iv) Written records of these assessments and any remedial action taken shall be kept and made available to either the local authority or the Licensing Authority when requested.
- (11) (i) A suitable noise complaints procedure must be established and in operation at the premises (e.g. all staff must be familiar with the complaints procedure and any complaint(s) made in respect of the premises, its customers, staff and/or the activities carried on there must be investigated and remedied as soon as, and, so far as is reasonably practicable to prevent public nuisance).
  - (ii) Suitable written records (e.g. the nature of any complaint(s), action(s) taken in response, the date(s) and time(s) when any complaint was made, together with the name of the person(s) who handled the complaint) must be kept and made available to officers of Rushmoor Borough Council on request.
- (12) There shall be no live music / Karaoke between 24:00midnight and the end of opening hours on any day.
- (13) Disposal of refuse such as waste bottles into external receptacles, where the noise may be audible to neighbouring properties, shall not occur between 23:00pm and 08:00am.
- (14) All external areas of the premises shall be closed to members, guests and members of the public and remain closed (i.e. vacated) between 23:00pm and the end of the opening hours on any day. Existing patrons shall be asked to leave the area quietly.
- (15) (i) All lighting, including external lighting and lights activated by sensors, shall be correctly adjusted so that it only illuminates the surface intended and does not throw light onto neighbouring properties.
  - (ii) External lights shall be provided with properly designed screen, baffles, hoods and louvers to control the beam.
  - (iii) External lights shall be switched off when the premises are not in use for licensable activities.



- (16) (i) Prominent, clear and legible notices must be displayed within the premises requesting patrons to dispose of litter responsibly.
  - (ii) Suitable and sufficient litterbins shall be provided within the premises or at the exits of the premises to assist with this requirement.
  - (iii) The area in the immediate vicinity of the premises shall be cleared of litter on a regular basis and always at the close of business.
- (17) Customer toilets shall be checked at regular intervals and cleaned as necessary.
- (18) Suitable and sufficient supplies of first aid equipment / materials must be made available to members, guests and members of the public on request. Dependant on the activities, events and risks at the premises, a suitably trained first aider or an appointed person for first aid must also be present on the premises at all times during licensable activities.
- (19) All staff shall be made aware of the conditions of this club premises certificate by a mechanism in writing.




