Qualifying club activities authorised by the certificate

- (1) The supply of alcohol to members and bona fide guests;
- (2) The provision of regulated entertainment by way of indoor sporting events;
- (3) The provision of regulated entertainment by way of live music (indoors and outdoors);
- (4) The provision of regulated entertainment by way of recorded music (indoors only);
- (5) The provision of regulated entertainment by way of anything of a similar description to that falling within (3) and (4) above (indoors only); and
- (6) The provision of facilities for dancing (indoors only).

Times the certificate authorises the carrying out of qualifying club activities

- (1) The supply of alcohol to members and bona fide guests:-
 - Sunday to Thursday – 10:00am to 00:30am the following day;
 - Friday's and Saturday's - 10:00am to 01:30am the following day;
 - On Christmas Eve (24th December), Boxing Day (26th December) and New Years Eve (31st December) – 10:00am to 01:30am the following day;
 - When televised sporting events occur in the mornings (UK time), the supply of alcohol may commence from 07:00am and continue until the permitted terminal hour of the day when screening said events.

- (2) The provision of regulated entertainment by way of indoor sporting events
 - Sunday to Thursday – 10:00am to 00:30am the following day;
 - Friday's and Saturday's - 10:00am to 01:30am the following day;

- (3) The provision of regulated entertainment by way of live music:-
 - Monday to Sunday - 10:00am to 23:00pm; and
 - On Christmas Eve (24th December) and New Years Eve (31st December) – 10:00am to 01:00am the following day

- (4) The provision of regulated entertainment by way of recorded music and the provision of facilities for dancing:-
 - Sunday to Thursday – 10:00am to 24:00midnight;
 - Friday's and Saturday's - 10:00am to 01:00am the following day; and
 - On Christmas Eve (24th December) and New Years Eve (31st December) – 10:00am to 02:00am the following day

- (5) The provision of regulated entertainment by way of anything similar to live or recorded music:-
 - Sunday to Thursday – 10:00am to 24:00midnight
 - Friday's and Saturday's – 10:00am to 01:00 am the following day

Annex 2 – Conditions consistent with the club Operating Schedule

- (1) No qualifying club activities shall be undertaken except during permitted hours.
- (2) As regards the supply of alcohol, the above restriction does not prohibit:-
 - (i) During the first twenty minutes after the above hours, the consumption of the alcohol on the premises;
 - (ii) During the first twenty minutes after the above hours, the taking of alcohol from the premises, unless the alcohol is supplied or taken in an open vessel;
 - (iii) During the first thirty minutes after the above hours, the consumption of the alcohol on the premises by persons taking meals there if the alcohol was supplied as ancillary to the meals; and
 - (iv) The supply to, or consumption by, any person of alcohol in any premises where they are residing.
- (3) The premises shall remain open for thirty minutes following the cessation of the supply of alcohol. This thirty-minute period shall be for sale of non-alcoholic beverages, drinking up and the use of lavatories only.
- (4) All members of any other club(s) and/or organisation(s) afforded use of the premises for qualifying club activities shall have been accepted for associate membership of Aldershot Cricket Club before being permitted use of the premises for such activities.
- (5) Suitable and sufficient supplies of first aid equipment / materials must be made available to members, guests and members of the public on request. Dependant on the activities, events and risks at the premises, a suitably trained first aider or an appointed person for first aid must also be present on the premises at all times during licensable activities.
- (6) Except for access and egress, all external doors and windows of the premises must be closed and kept closed between 22:00pm and the end of opening hours on any day.
- (7) No music or speech shall be relayed via external speakers, other than for events with the prior approval of the licensing authority.
- (8)
 - (i) No music or speech shall be relayed via external speakers other than for events with the prior approval of the licensing authority.

- (ii) Except where otherwise approved in accordance with the above, speakers and other such amplification equipment shall be kept within the premises and shall not be positioned near to or facing openings such as doors and windows.
- (9)
 - (i) Prominent, clear and legible notices shall be suitably located at all exits of the premises requesting members, guests and staff to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and area quietly.
 - (ii) So far as is reasonably practicable, members and bona fide guests shall actively be reminded on leaving the premises to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and area quietly.
- (10)
 - (i) The licence holder or a nominated responsible representative(s) shall carry out a regular noise assessment of the area adjacent to the premises whilst licensable activities are taking place.
 - (ii) Noise assessments shall take place at the Guildford Road entrance gates to the cricket ground, and if audible, steps shall be taken to reduce noise from the premises to a level where noise is no longer audible at the monitoring points.
 - (iii) These assessments should be undertaken at half hourly intervals from 23:00pm until the end of permitted opening hours.
 - (iv) Written records of these assessments and any remedial action(s) taken shall be kept and made available to either the local authority or the Licensing Authority on request.
- (11)
 - (i) A suitable noise complaints procedure must be established and be in operation at the premises (e.g. all relevant persons must be familiar with the complaints procedure and any complaint(s) made in respect of the premises, its members, guests, any staff and/or the activities carried on there must be investigated and remedied as soon as, and, so far as is reasonably practicable to prevent public nuisance).
 - (ii) Suitable written records of such complaints must be kept and made available to either the local authority or the Licensing Authority on request (e.g. the nature of any complaint(s), action(s) taken in response, the date(s) and time(s) when any complaint was made, together with the name of the person(s) who handled the complaint).

- (12) Notwithstanding condition (10) above, the volume of recorded music shall be reduced such that it is at a background level(s) during the final 30-minutes of the opening hours of the premises.
- (13) All staff / employees shall be given suitable and sufficient written guidance and training on noise control to a level commensurate with their role(s), responsibilities and duties. This shall include information regarding the limitation of noise from the licensed premises, patrons and staff.
- (14) Disposal of refuse such as waste bottles into external receptacles, where the noise may be audible to neighbouring properties, shall not occur between 23:00pm and 08:00am.
- (15) All garden / external drinking areas shall be closed and vacated between 24:00midnight and the end of specified opening hours on any day. Existing patrons in the area at this time shall be asked to leave the area quietly.
- (16)
 - (i) All lighting including external lighting and lights activated by sensors shall be correctly adjusted so that they only illuminate the surface(s) intended and do not unreasonably throw light onto neighbouring property.
 - (i) External lights shall be provided with properly designed screens, baffles, hoods and louvers to control the beam.
 - (ii) All external lights shall be turned off when the premises are not in being used for the provision of licensable activities or otherwise in use.
- (17) All committee members and other relevant persons shall be provided with appropriate written guidance and training on noise control, inclusive of information regarding limiting noise from the licensed premises, members and employees.
- (18) The area in the immediate vicinity of the premises shall be cleared of litter on a regular basis and always at the close of business.
- (19) All toilets at the premises shall be checked at hourly intervals and cleaned as necessary.
