Qualifying club activities authorised by the certificate

- (1) The supply of alcohol to members and bona fide guests;
- (2) The provision of regulated entertainment by way of live music (indoors and outdoors);
- (3) The provision of regulated entertainment by way of recorded music (indoors and outdoors); and
- (4) The provision of regulated entertainment by way of the performance of dance (indoors only).



Times the certificate authorises the carrying out of qualifying club activities

- (1) The supply of alcohol to members and bona fide guests:-
 - Sunday to Thursday (other than Christmas Day or Good Friday) 11:00am to 23:00pm;
 - Friday's and Saturday's (other than Christmas Day or Good Friday) –
 11:00am to 00:00midnight;
 - Christmas Eve 11:00am to 00:00midnight; and
 - ➤ New Years Eve 11:00am to 01:00am the following day;
 - On Good Friday 12:00noon to 22:30pm; and
 - On Christmas Day, as provided by the rules of the club and notified in writing by the chairman or secretary of the club to the licensing authority. The said hours shall:-
 - (i) Not exceed six and a half hours;
 - (ii) Not begin earlier than 12:00noon:
 - (iii) Not end later than 22:30pm;
 - (iv) Provide for a break of at least 2 hours, including 15:00pm to 17:00pm; and
 - (v) Not extend for more than three and a half hours after 17:00pm.
- (2) The provision of regulated entertainment by way of live music (including Karaoke) 11:00am to 23:00pm on any day.
- (3) For all other authorised qualifying club activities:-
 - Sunday to Thursday 11:00am to 23:30pm;
 - Friday's and Saturday's 11:00am to 00:30am the following day;
 - ➤ On Christmas Eve 11:00am to 00:30am the following day; and
 - ➤ On New Years Eve 11:00am to 01:30am the following day.

The opening hours of the club

- Sunday to Thursday 11:00am to 23:30pm;
- Friday's and Saturday's 11:00am to 00:30am the following day;
- ➤ On Christmas Eve 11:00am to 00:30am the following day; and
- ➤ On New Years Eve 11:00am to 01:30am the following day.

Where the certificate authorises supplies of alcohol whether these are on and/or off supplies

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the club Operating Schedule

- (1) Qualifying club activities shall not be undertaken except during permitted hours.
- (2) With respect to the sale / supply of alcohol, the above restriction does not prohibit:
 - (i) During the first thirty minutes after the above hours the consumption of the alcohol on the premises;
 - (ii) During the first thirty minutes after the above hours, the taking of the alcohol from the premises unless the alcohol is supplied or taken in an open vessel;
 - (iii) During the first thirty minutes after the above hours the consumption of the alcohol on the premises by persons taking meals there if the alcohol was supplied as ancillary to the meals;
 - (iv) The supply to, or consumption by, any person of alcohol in any premises where they are residing.
- (3) (i) No individual(s) under the age of 18 (eighteen) shall be permitted to purchase or drink alcohol on the premises.
 - (ii) In pursuance of the above, anyone authorised to supply alcohol at the premises shall request and ensure sight of suitable identification, for proof of age, of any person appearing to them to be under the age of 18 (eighteen) and who is attempting to purchase / obtain alcohol. Alcohol shall not sold / supplied to any such individual where appropriate proof (proving they are over the age of 18) is not produced.
- (4) (i) All members of the club shall be made aware of, and reminded as may be appropriate, the law concerning the sale / supply of alcohol to, and consumption by individuals under the age of 18 (eighteen).
 - (ii) In particular, members and / or employees authorised to supply alcohol shall receive suitable and sufficient training in the law and their responsibilities concerning the sale / supply of alcohol to individual(s) under the age of 18 (eighteen).
 - (iii) In pursuance of the above, all individuals authorised to supply alcohol at the premises shall read the relevant section of the BIIAB handbook for the Level 2 National Certificate for Personal Licence Holders (or equivalent accredited qualification).



- (5) Any individual(s) who may come into contact with children at the premises shall be vetted in accordance with the relevant and extant policies and procedures of the England and Wales Cricket Board (ECB).
- (6) Except for access and egress, all external doors and windows must be closed and kept closed between 22:00pm and the end of the opening hours on any day.
- (7) No music or speech shall be relayed via external speakers other than for events with the prior approval of the licensing authority.
- (8) The sound level arising from any amplification system(s) used on the premises shall be set at a level that ensures that noise from the premises is inaudible at the boundary of the nearest residential premises on all sides of the premises.
- (9) (i) The club secretary or nominated representative(s) shall carry out a regular noise assessment of the area adjacent to the premises whilst licensable activities are taking place.
 - (ii) Noise assessments shall take place on all sides of the premises at the boundary of the nearest residential premises, and if audible, steps shall be taken to reduce noise to a level where noise is no longer audible at the monitoring points.
 - (iii) These assessments shall be undertaken at hourly intervals from 22:00pm and the end of the opening hours on any day.
 - (iv) Suitable written records of these assessments and any remedial action(s) taken shall be kept and made available to either the local authority or the Licensing Authority when requested.
- (10) (i) A suitable noise complaints procedure must be established and in operation at the premises (e.g. all staff must be familiar with the complaints procedure and any complaint(s) made in respect of the premises, its customers, staff and/or the activities carried on there must be investigated and remedied as soon as, and, so far as is reasonably practicable to prevent public nuisance).
 - (ii) Suitable written records of such complaints must be kept and made available to officers of Rushmoor Borough Council on request (e.g. the nature of any complaint(s), action(s) taken in response, the date(s) and time(s) when any complaint was made, together with the name of the person(s) who handled the complaint).



- (11) Suitable and sufficient, prominent, clear and legible notices shall be located at all exits of the premises requesting patrons and staff to leave the premises and area quietly.
- (12) Disposal of refuse such as waste bottles into external receptacles, where the noise may be audible to neighbouring properties shall not occur between 22:00pm and 08:00am.
- (13) All external drinking areas of the premises shall be closed and remain closed and vacated between 23:00pm and the specified opening hours on any day.
- (14) All lighting including external lighting shall be correctly adjusted so that it only illuminates the surface(s) intended and does not throw light onto neighbouring property.
- (15) (i) Suitable and sufficient, prominent, clear and legible notices shall be displayed within the premises asking customers to dispose of litter responsibly.
 - (ii) Suitable and sufficient litterbins shall be provided for the disposal of litter either within the premises or at the exits.
- (16) Suitable and sufficient supplies of first aid equipment / materials must be made available to members of the public on request. Dependant on the activities, events and risks at the premises, a suitably trained first aider or an appointed person for first aid must also be present on the premises at all times during licensable activities.
- (17) All club committee members and bar staff shall be made aware of the conditions of this licence by a mechanism in writing.
