 - (ii) Not begin earlier than 12:00noon;
 - (iii) Not end later than 22:30pm;
 - (iv) Provide for a break of at least 2 hours, including 15:00pm to 17:00pm; and
 - (v) Not extend for more than three and a half hours after 17:00pm.
 - On New Year's Eve from the end of permitted hours on New Year's Eve to the start of permitted hours on the following day (or, if there are no permitted hours on the following day, midnight on 31st December).

*Except for live music, Karaoke or Disco's which shall finish no later than 00:00hrs.

Annex 2 – Conditions consistent with the club Operating Schedule

- 1) Alcohol shall not be sold or supplied except during permitted hours.
- 2) The above restriction does not prohibit:
 - (i) During the first twenty minutes after the above hours the consumption of the alcohol on the premises;
 - During the first twenty minutes after the above hours, the taking of the alcohol from the premises unless the alcohol is supplied or taken in an open vessel;
 - (iii) During the first thirty minutes after the above hours the consumption of the alcohol on the premises by persons taking meals there if the alcohol was supplied as ancillary to the meals;
 - (iv) The supply to, or consumption by, any person of alcohol in any premises where they are residing.
- (i) Children (under 18) not accompanied and supervised by a member who is an individual aged 18 or over shall not be permitted in or to remain on the premises at any time.
 - (ii) Notwithstanding the above, no child(ren) (under 18) shall be permitted in, or to remain in any bar area on the premises.
 - (iii) No child(ren) (under 18) shall be permitted on, or otherwise be allowed to play any gaming machine(s) on the premises.
- 4) Live music, karaoke and disco's shall finish no later than midnight on any day.
- 5) (i) No music or speech shall be relayed via external speakers other than for events with the prior approval of the licensing authority.
 - (ii) Except where otherwise approved in accordance with the above, speakers and other such amplification equipment shall be kept within the premises and shall not be positioned near to or facing openings such as doors and windows.
- 6) All sound amplification systems shall be set at a level that ensures that noise from the premises is inaudible at the boundary of the nearest residential premises, on all sides of the premises.
- 7) (i) The licence holder or a nominated representative shall carry out a regular noise assessment of the area adjacent to the premises at the boundary of the nearest residential premises, and if



audible, suitable steps must be taken to reduce noise from the premises to a level where noise is no longer audible at the monitoring points.

- (ii) These assessments must be undertaken at hourly intervals starting from 21:00pm.
- (iii) Written records of these assessments and any remedial action(s) taken shall be kept and made available to either the local authority or licensing authority on request.
- 8) (i) A suitable noise complaints procedure must be established and in operation at the premises (e.g. all staff must be familiar with the complaints procedure and any complaint(s) made in respect of the premises, its customers, staff and/or the activities carried on there must be investigated and remedied as soon as, and, so far as is reasonably practicable to prevent public nuisance).
 - (ii) Suitable written records (e.g. the nature of any complaint(s), action(s) taken in response, the date(s) and time(s) when any complaint was made, together with the name of the person(s) who handled the complaint) must be kept and made available to officers of Rushmoor Borough Council on request.
- (i) Except for access and egress, all external doors and windows of the premises must be closed and kept closed between 21:00pm and the end of opening hours on any day.
 - (ii) So as to facilitate compliance with condition 9(i) above, the premises must be fitted with and maintain the use of acoustically treated ventilation / air conditioning.
- 10) Disposal of refuse such as waste bottles into external receptacles where the noise may be audible to neighbouring properties must not occur between 23:00pm and 08:00am.
- 11) All lighting (including external lighting) shall be correctly adjusted so that it only illuminates the surface(s) intended and do(es) not unreasonably throw light onto neighbouring property.
- 12) (i) Suitable and sufficient notices shall be displayed within the premises asking customers to dispose of litter responsibly.
 - (ii) Suitable and sufficient litterbins shall be provided both within the premises and at the exits of the premises for this purpose.
- 13) Customer toilets shall be checked at hourly intervals and cleaned as necessary.

- 14) Suitable and sufficient supplies of first aid equipment / materials must be made available to members, guests and members of the public on request. Dependant on the activities, events and risks at the premises, a suitably trained first aider or an appointed person for first aid must also be present on the premises at all times during licensable activities.
- 15) All committee members, stewards and bar staff shall be made aware of the conditions of this licence by a mechanism in writing.



Annex 3 – Conditions attached after a hearing by the licensing authority

- (i) Prominent, clear and legible notices shall be suitably located at all exits of the premises requesting members, guests and staff to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and area quietly.
 - (ii) So far as is reasonably practicable, members and bona fide guests shall actively be reminded on leaving the premises to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and area quietly.


OTHER ADVISORY NOTES:
