Annex 2 – Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

- (1) No licensable activities shall be undertaken except during permitted hours.
- (2) The licence holder or other nominated representative for the premises shall actively participate in any local Shopwatch scheme.
- (3)
 - (i) A suitable and sufficient CCTV camera system linked to suitable recording facilities shall be operational at the premises at all times during the provision of licensable activities.
 - (ii) The CCTV system and associated facilities shall adequately cover both the internal and external areas of the premises; surveying both the public areas and the immediate vicinity respectively.
 - (iii) So far as is reasonably practicable, all cameras must be maintained in good working order at all times.
 - (iv) Footage / recordings from the CCTV system shall be securely retained for a minimum of 28 days.
- (4) All employees and staff at the premises shall be given suitable and sufficient training on how to appropriately manage problem / disruptive customers to a level commensurate with their duties and responsibilities.
- (5)
 - (i) Alcohol shall not be consumed on the premises at any time.
 - (ii) Suitable and sufficient notices shall be displayed in the premises advising that consumption of alcohol is not permitted on the premises at any time. Such notices shall be so positioned as to enable them to be visible from all publicly accessible areas of the premises.
- (6) Suitable and sufficient safety focussed (including fire safety) risk assessments shall be undertaken in connection with the premises and the activities carried on there. Whereupon, suitable and sufficient controls or monitoring arrangements shall be implemented as may be appropriate. All risk assessments shall be regularly reviewed.
- (7) The premises shall be maintained in a clean condition at all times.
- (8) The electrical installation and any electrical appliances / systems at the premises must be maintained so as to prevent danger and be covered by a valid certificate of examination and testing signed by a competent electrical contractor.

- (9) Except for access and egress, all external doors and windows must be closed and kept closed between 22:00pm and the end of the opening hours on any day.
- (10) Prominent, clear and legible notices must be displayed at all exits of the premises requesting patrons and staff to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and area quietly.
- (11) Disposal of refuse into external receptacles, where the noise may be audible to neighbouring properties shall not occur between 22:00pm and 08:00am.
- (12)
 - (i) A suitable noise complaints procedure must be established and be in operation at the premises (e.g. all staff must be familiar with the complaints procedure and any complaint(s) made in respect of the premises, its customers, staff and/or the activities carried on there must be investigated and remedied as soon as, and, so far as is reasonably practicable to prevent public nuisance).
 - (ii) Suitable written records (e.g. the nature of any complaint(s), action(s) taken in response, the date(s) and time(s) when any complaint was made, together with the name of the person(s) who handled the complaint) must be kept and made available to officers of Rushmoor Borough Council on request.
- (13) All employees and staff shall be provided with suitable and sufficient information, instruction and / or training to ensure that the manner in which they close / secure the premises at the close of business each day does not cause noise disturbance / nuisance to neighbouring residents.
- (14) All lighting, including external lighting, shall be correctly adjusted so that it only illuminates the surface intended and does not unreasonably throw light onto neighbouring properties.
- (15)
 - (i) Suitable, sufficient, prominent, clear and legible notices must be displayed within the premises requesting patrons to dispose of litter responsibly.
 - (ii) Suitable and sufficient litterbins shall be provided within the premises and/or at the exits of the premises.
 - (iii) The area in the immediate vicinity of the premises shall be cleared of litter on a regular basis and always at the close of business.
- (16) All employees and staff shall be made aware of the conditions attached to this licence by a mechanism in writing.
