- (4) On New Years Eve from the end of permitted hours on New Years Eve to the start of permitted hours on the following day (or, if there are no permitted hours on the following day, midnight on 31st December).

The opening hours of the premises

- (1) Monday to Saturday – 11:00am to 24:00midnight;
- (2) Sunday's – 12:00noon to 23:30pm;
- (3) On Good Friday, Christmas Day & New Year's Eve - 11:00am to 24:00midnight;
- (4) On New Years Eve from the end of permitted hours on New Years Eve to the start of permitted hours on the following day (or, if there are no permitted hours on the following day, midnight on 31st December).

Annex 1 – Mandatory conditions

- (1) No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence:-
 - (i) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
 - (ii) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his/her personal licence is suspended.
- (2) Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

Annex 2 – Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

- (1) Intoxicating liquor may be supplied on the premises only to persons who are taking table meals there and as an ancillary to that meal.
- (2) Alcohol shall not be sold or supplied except during permitted hours.
- (3) The above restriction does not prohibit:-
 - (i) during the first twenty minutes after the above hours, the consumption of the alcohol on the premises:
 - (ii) during the first twenty minutes after the above hours, the taking of the alcohol from the premises unless the alcohol is supplied or taken in an open vessel;
 - (iii) during the first thirty minutes after the above hours the consumption of the alcohol on the premises by persons taking meals there if the alcohol was supplied for consumption as ancillary to the meals;
 - (iv) consumption of the alcohol on the premises or the taking of sale or supply of alcohol to any person residing in the licensed premises;
- (4) Suitable beverages other than intoxicating liquor (incl. Drinking water) shall be equally available for consumption with or otherwise as an ancillary to meals served in the licensed premises.
- (5) The premises must be bona fide used for the purpose of habitually providing the customary main meal at midday or in the evening, or both, for the accommodation of persons frequenting the premises.
- (6)
 - (i) Any garden and/or external areas shall be closed for the provision of licensable activities and/or the consumption of food and drink (including alcohol) after 22:30pm on any day. Exiting patrons shall be asked to leave the area quietly.
 - (ii) Any garden and/or external areas shall be available only for the use of smokers after 22:30pm on any day.
- (7)
 - (i) The licence holder or nominated representative(s) shall carry out a regular noise assessment of the area adjacent to the premises whilst licensable activities take place.
 - (ii) Noise assessments shall take place on all sides of the premises at the boundary of the nearest residential premises, and if audible, steps shall be taken to reduce noise from the premises to a level where noise is no longer audible at the monitoring points.

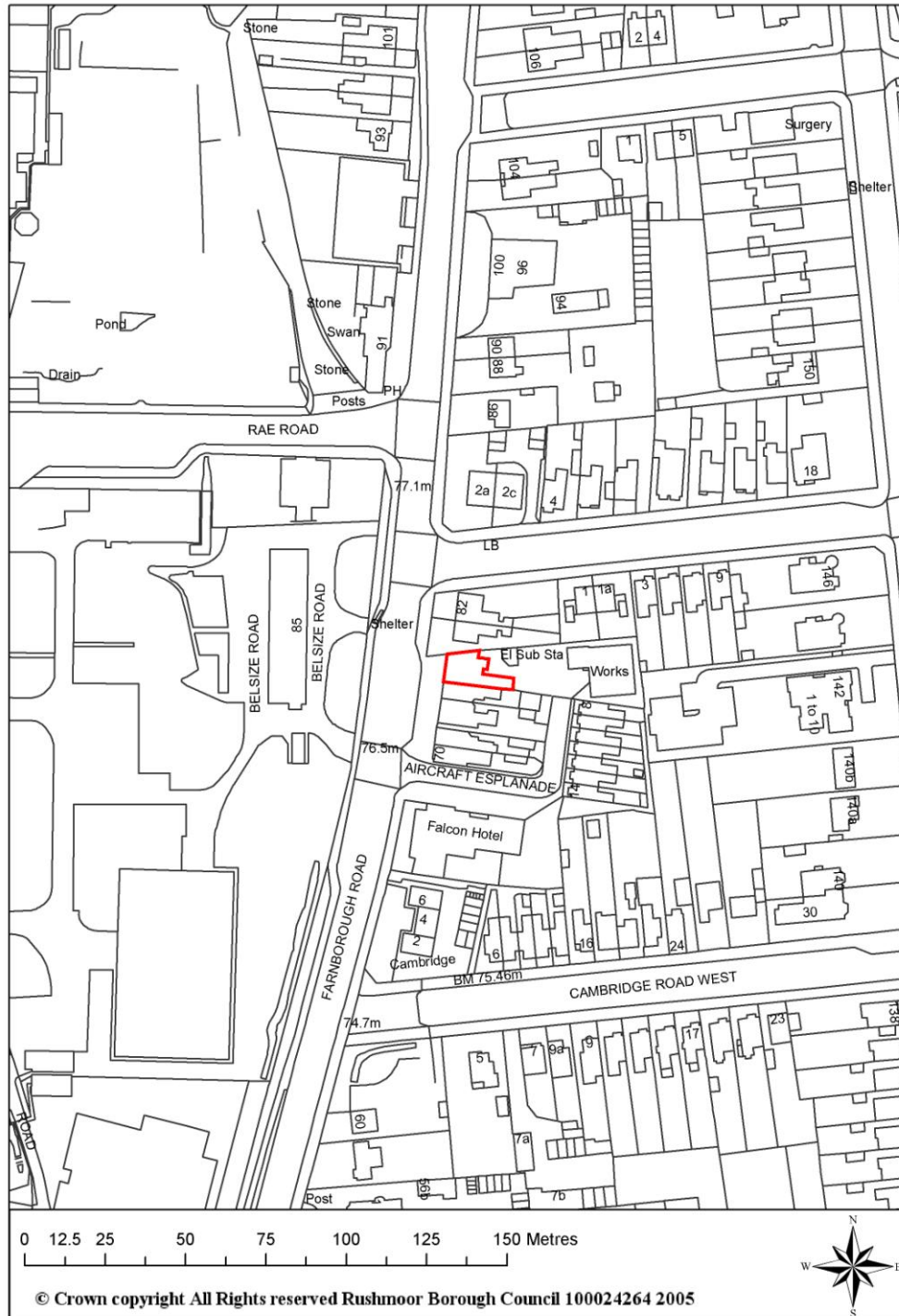
- (iii) Noise assessments shall be undertaken at hourly intervals from 20:00pm.
 - (iv) Written records of these assessments and any remedial action(s) taken shall be kept and made available to either the local authority or the Licensing Authority when requested.
- (8)
- (i) Suitable and sufficient, prominent, clear and legible notices shall be displayed within the premises asking customers to dispose of litter responsibly.
 - (ii) Suitable and sufficient litterbins, including suitable receptacles for waste arising from smoking activities, shall be provided for this purpose either within the premises or at the exits.
 - (iii) The area in the immediate vicinity of the premises shall be cleared of litter, including waste arising from smoking activities on a regular basis and always at the close of business each day.
- (9) All staff / employees shall be made aware of the conditions of this licence by a mechanism in writing.
