Annex 1 – Mandatory conditions

- (1) No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence:-
 - (i) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or

- (ii) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his/her personal licence is suspended.
- (2) Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.
- (3) (i) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.
- (ii) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.

Annex 2 – Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

- (1) The area in the immediate vicinity of the premises shall be cleared of litter, including waste arising from smoking activities on a regular basis and always at the close of business.
- (2)
 - (i) A suitable CCTV camera system linked to a suitable recording facility shall be in operation at the premises for the purposes of preventing crime and disorder.
 - (ii) So far as is reasonably practicable, all cameras must be maintained in good working order.
 - (iii) CCTV recordings and footage must be retained for a minimum period of 7 (seven) days and be made available for review by the Police upon request (subject to the requirements of the Data Protection legislation in force at the time).
- (3) Anyone authorised to sell or supply alcohol at the premises shall request and ensure sight of suitable identification, for proof of age, of any person appearing to them to be under the age of 18 (eighteen) and who is attempting to purchase alcohol. The sale of alcohol shall be refused to any person that cannot provide suitable proof of age.
- (4) Suitable and sufficient warning signs shall be displayed in the premises providing general information as to the relevant age restrictions and offences for purchase of age-restricted products (including alcohol).
- (5) A minimum of **two (2)** staff, must be in attendance at the premises at all times when licensable activities are taking place.
- (6) A written log shall be kept of all refusals including refusals to sell alcohol. The premises licence holder shall ensure that the refusals log is properly maintained and this shall involve, but is not limited to, nominating in writing a responsible person to check and sign it on a weekly basis.
- (6)
 - (i) All staff / employees shall (before being permitted to make sales of alcohol) be given suitable and sufficient training in relation to the lawful sale of alcohol and the procedures adopted at the premises in respect of alcohol sales to a level commensurate with their role and responsibilities. This training shall be refreshed on a regular basis, and at least every 6 months.
 - (ii) Written records of such training and refresher training shall be kept and made available to either the local authority or the licensing authority on request.
