- The supply of alcohol to members and bona fide guests
- The provision of regulated entertainment by way of live music including karaoke (indoors only).

Times the certificate authorises the carrying out of qualifying club activities

(1) The Supply of alcohol to members and bona fide guests:-

- Monday to Wednesday – 11:00am to 23:30pm;
- Thursday's and Sunday's – 11:00am to 23:00pm;
- Friday's and Saturday's – 11:00am to 00:30am the following day;
- On Good Friday - 12:00noon to 22:30pm;
- On New Years Eve from the start of permitted hours to the start of permitted hours the following day; and
- On Christmas day, as provided by the rules of the club and notified in writing by the chairman or secretary of the club to the licensing authority. The said hours shall:-

- (i) Not exceed six and a half hours;
- (ii) Not begin earlier than 12:00noon;
- (iii) Not end later than 22:30pm;
- (iv) Provide for a break of at least 2 hours, including 15:00pm to 17:00pm; and
- (v) Not extend for more than three and a half hours after 17:00pm.

(2) The provision of regulated entertainment by way of live music including karaoke (indoors only);

- Friday's and Saturdays – 19:00pm to 00:00 midnight;
- Sunday's – 12:00pm to 20:00pm; and
- On New Years Eve from the start of permitted hours until 02:00am the following day.

The opening hours of the club

- Monday to Thursday – 11:00am to 00:00 midnight;
- Friday's and Saturday's – 11:00am to 01:00am the following day;
- Sunday's – 11:00am to 23:30pm; and
- On New Years Eve from the start of permitted hours to the start of permitted hours the following day.

Where the certificate authorises supplies of alcohol whether these are on and/or off supplies

- Alcohol may be supplied for consumption ON the premises ONLY

Annex 1 – Mandatory conditions

- (1) (i) The responsible person shall take all reasonable steps to ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises.
- (ii) For the purposes of this condition, an irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises in a manner which carries a significant risk of leading or contributing to crime and disorder, prejudice to public safety, public nuisance, or harm to children –
- (a) games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require or encourage, individuals to –
- (i) drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol), or
- (ii) drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);
- (b) provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic (other than any promotion or discount available to an individual in respect of alcohol for consumption at a table meal, as defined in section 159 of the Act);
- (c) provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less;
- (d) provision of free or discounted alcohol in relation to the viewing on the premises of a sporting event, where that provision is dependent on –
- (i) the outcome of a race, competition or other event or process, or
- (ii) the likelihood of anything occurring or not occurring;
- (e) selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise

anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner.

- (2) The responsible person shall ensure that no alcohol is dispensed directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of a disability).
- (3) The responsible person shall ensure that free tap water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.
- (4) (i) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.

(ii) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.
- (5) The responsible person shall ensure that –
 - (a) where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures –
 - (i) beer or cider: ½ pint;
 - (ii) gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25 ml or 35 ml; and
 - (iii) still wine in a glass: 125 ml; and
 - (b) customers are made aware of the availability of these measures

Annex 2 – Conditions consistent with the club Operating Schedule

- 1) Alcohol shall not be sold or supplied except during permitted hours.
- 2) The above restriction does not prohibit:
 - (i) During the first twenty minutes after the above hours the consumption of the alcohol on the premises;
 - (ii) During the first twenty minutes after the above hours, the taking of the alcohol from the premises unless the alcohol is supplied or taken in an open vessel;
 - (iii) During the first thirty minutes after the above hours the consumption of the alcohol on the premises by persons taking meals there if the alcohol was supplied as ancillary to the meals;
 - (iv) The supply to, or consumption by, any person of alcohol in any premises where they are residing.
- 3)
 - (i) Anyone authorised to sell or supply alcohol at the premises shall request and ensure sight of suitable identification, for proof of age, of any person appearing to them to be under the age of 21 (twenty-one) and who is attempting to purchase alcohol.
 - (ii) Further to the above, anyone authorised to sell or supply alcohol at the premises shall be instructed that no sale of alcohol shall be made unless suitable identification, for proof of age, can be provided.
 - (iii) Suitable and sufficient warning signs shall be displayed in the premises providing information in respect of the above challenge 21 policy and the request for suitable identification in connection thereof.
- 4)
 - (i) A suitable and sufficient CCTV camera system, linked to a suitable recording facility must be in operation at the premises at all times when licensable activities are taking place.
 - (ii) So far as is reasonably practicable, the CCTV system must be maintained in good working order at all times.
 - (iii) CCTV recordings and footage must be retained for a minimum period of 31 (thirty-one) days and be made available for review by the Police upon request (subject to the data protection legislation in force at the time).

- 5) (i) A secure door system must be in operation at the premises at all times.

(ii) At the weekends a receptionist shall be employed to check memberships on entry to the premises.
- 6) Except for access and egress, all external doors and windows must be closed and kept closed between 22:00pm and the end of the specified opening hours on any day.
- 7) Prominent, clear and legible notices must be displayed at all exits requesting patrons and staff to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and area quietly.
- 8) A member of the committee must be present at the premises at all times that licensable activities are taking place.
- 9) Persons under 18 years of age shall not be served at the bar.
