Annex 2 – Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

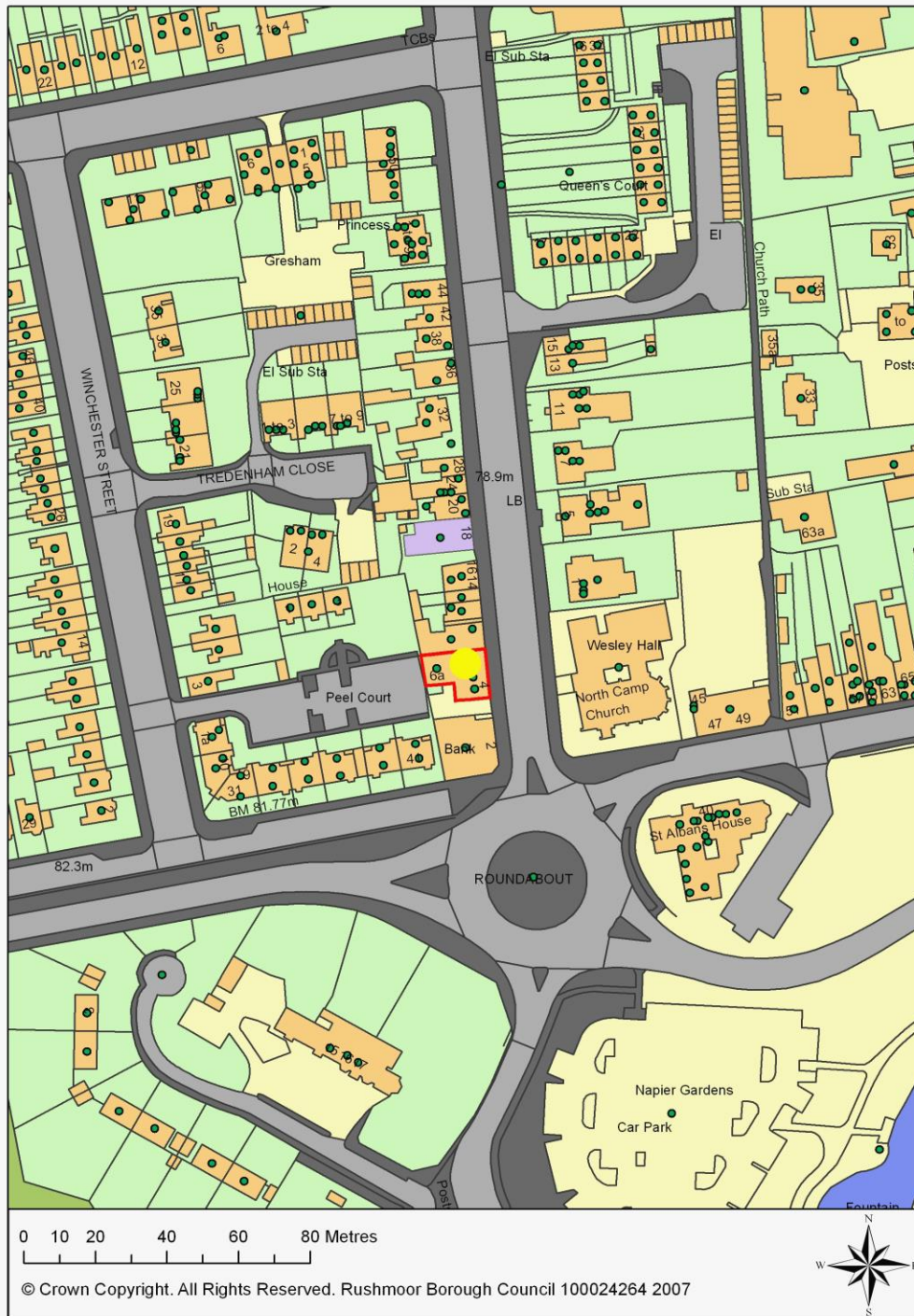
- (1) No licensable activities shall be undertaken except during permitted hours.
- (2) The extract ventilation system(s) serving the premises shall be of such construction, design and otherwise be suitably maintained so as to ensure no noise emissions are created that are capable of causing noise nuisance to adjacent residential properties.
- (3)
 - (i) Prominent, clear and legible notices shall be displayed at all exits of the premises, requesting patrons and staff to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and area quietly.
 - (ii) Where reasonably practicable, management and staff shall proactively reiterate the need for patrons and staff to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and area quietly when they leave the premises.
- (4)
 - (i) A suitable noise complaints procedure must be established and be in operation at the premises (e.g. all staff must be familiar with the complaints procedure and any complaint(s) made in respect of the premises, its customers, staff and/or the activities carried on there must be investigated and remedied as soon as, and, so far as is reasonably practicable to prevent public nuisance).
 - (ii) Suitable written records (e.g. the nature of any complaint(s), action(s) taken in response, the date(s) and time(s) when any complaint was made, together with the name of the person(s) who handled the complaint) must be kept and made available to officers of Rushmoor Borough Council on request.
- (5) The area in the immediate vicinity of the premises shall be cleared of litter on a regular basis and always at the close of business.
- (6)
 - (i) A suitable CCTV camera system linked to a suitable recording facility must be in operation at the premises during permitted hours and be sufficient so as to promote the prevention of crime and disorder both within and in the immediate vicinity of the premises.
 - (ii) So far as is reasonably practicable, the CCTV system must be maintained in good working order at all times.
 - (iii) CCTV recordings and footage must be retained for a minimum period of 7 (seven) days and be made available for review by the Police or Licensing Authority upon request.
- (7) Anyone authorised to provide late night refreshment on the premises shall refuse service to any person appearing to them to be intoxicated with alcohol.
- (8) All employees shall be made aware of the conditions attached to this licence by a mechanism in writing.
