Annex 2 – Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

- (1) No licensable activities shall be undertaken except during permitted hours.
- (2) All incidences of crime and disorder within or in the immediate vicinity of the premises shall be recorded in a store diary provided for this purpose.
- (3)
 - (i) A suitable and sufficient CCTV camera system with a suitable recording facility shall be operational in the premises during the provision of licensable activities.
 - (ii) So far as is reasonably practicable, all cameras must be maintained in good working order at all times.
 - (iii) Footage / recordings from the CCTV system shall be securely retained for a minimum of 28 days.
 - (iii) Suitable and sufficient, prominent, clear and legible notices shall be displayed within the premises advising of the presence and purpose of the CCTV system.
- (4) Suitable and sufficient emergency panic buttons directly linked to a 24-hour monitoring service shall be operational within the premises at all times.
- (5) All fire safety equipment, gas equipment and electrical appliances shall be suitably maintained and at all times and be the subject of a valid / current certificate of test and examination by a competent person.
- (6)
 - (i) The licence holder shall ensure that all 'shift-runners' are suitably and sufficiently trained in the provision of first aid.
 - (ii) Suitable and sufficient supplies of first aid equipment / materials must be made available to members of the public on request.
- (7)
 - (i) All areas on the premises to which the public have access shall be designated as non-smoking areas.
 - (ii) Suitable and sufficient, prominent, clear and legible notices shall be displayed within the premises advising of this policy.
- (8)
 - (i) No refreshments shall be served using glass containers.

- (ii) A no-glass policy shall be established in respect of the preparation and handling of refreshments on the premises and actively enforced at all times.
- (9) Except for access and egress, all external doors and windows must be closed and kept closed between 21:00pm and the end of the opening hours on any day.
- (10) Prominent, clear and legible notices must be displayed at all exits requesting patrons and staff to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and area quietly.
- (11)
 - (i) A suitable noise / odour complaints procedure must be established and be in operation at the premises (e.g. all staff must be familiar with the complaints procedure and any complaint(s) made in respect of the premises, its customers, staff and/or the activities carried on there must be investigated and remedied as soon as, and, so far as is reasonably practicable to prevent public nuisance).
 - (ii) Suitable written records (e.g. the nature of any complaint(s), action(s) taken in response, the date(s) and time(s) when any complaint was made, together with the name of the person(s) who handled the complaint) must be kept and made available to officers of Rushmoor Borough Council on request.
- (12) All lighting, including external lighting, shall be correctly adjusted so that it only illuminates the surface intended and does not throw light onto neighbouring properties.
- (13)
 - (i) Suitable, sufficient, prominent, clear and legible notices must be displayed within the premises requesting patrons to dispose of litter responsibly.
 - (ii) Suitable and sufficient litterbins shall be provided within the premises and/or at the exits of the premises. All litterbins so provided shall be emptied and cleaned on a daily basis.
 - (iii) In accordance with the Department for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs voluntary code of practice regarding litter caused by food on the go, the area in the immediate vicinity of the premises shall be cleared of litter emanating from the premises on a regular basis and always at the close of business.
- (14) All employees shall be made aware of the conditions attached to this licence by a mechanism in writing.
