Annex 2 – Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

- (1) No licensable activities shall be undertaken except during permitted hours.
- (2) No food or drink shall be served in glass receptacles.
- (3)
 - (i) A suitable and sufficient CCTV (Kalagate certified) camera system linked to a suitable recording facility, shall, so far as is reasonably practicable, be operational at the premises during any period in which licensable activities are permitted.
 - (ii) So far as is reasonably practicable, the CCTV system must be maintained in good working order at all times, and shall be regularly serviced by a qualified maintenance technician.
 - (iii) CCTV recordings and footage must be retained for a minimum period of 28 (twenty-eight) days and be made available for review by the Police upon request (subject to the requirements of the Data Protection legislation in force at the time).
 - (iv) Suitable and sufficient warning signs shall be displayed in the public areas of the premises advising that CCTV is in operation at the premises.
 - (v) A competent person conversant with the operation and retrieval of information contained in the CCTV system / footage shall be available to provide immediate copies of footage to the police on request.
 - (vi) The CCTV system shall be fitted with an alarm to alert staff when the system is faulty or is not recording.
- (3) Alcohol in open containers shall not be permitted in the store at any time.
- (4) All staff at the premises shall be trained in safety, security and emergency evacuation procedures, to a level commensurate with their duties and responsibilities.
- (5) All external doors used by customers shall be fitted with self-closing devices.
- (6) The area in the immediate vicinity of the premises shall be cleared of litter, including waste arising from smoking activities, on a regular basis, and always at the end of each working day. This shall also include litter on public pavements and public land within a radius of 100 metres of the premises. Litter shall be disposed of appropriately.

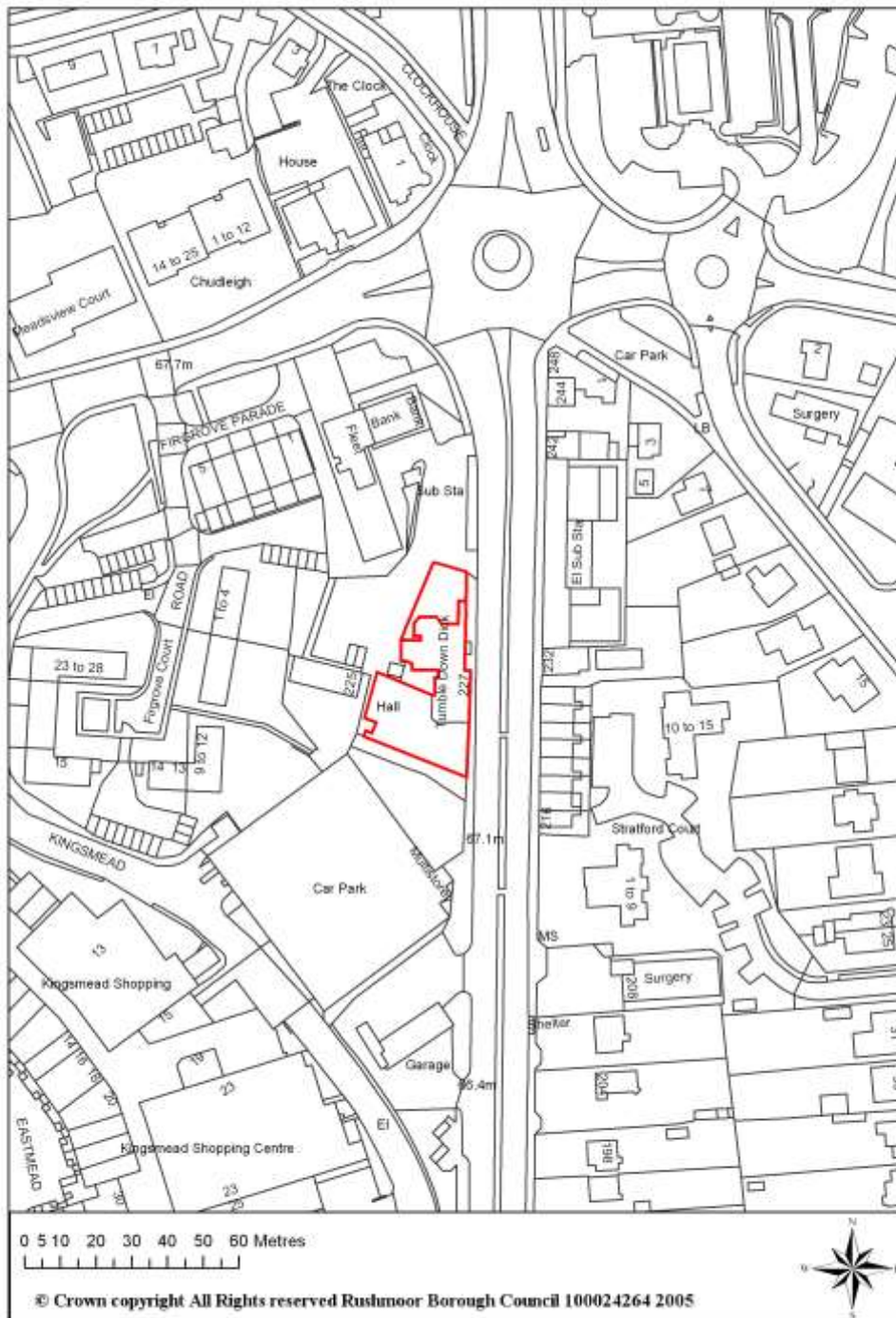
- (7) Suitable and sufficient refuse bins shall be provided within the parking area of the premises, and on the pavement at the front of the premises and parking area.
- (8) During the hours between 00:00(midnight) and 05:00am the restaurant will trade as a drive-thru only.
