Annex 2 – Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

- (1)
 - (i) A suitable and sufficient digital CCTV camera system linked to a suitable recording facility, which captures images of evidential quality, shall be operational at the premises during any period in which licensable activities are permitted.
 - (ii) As part of the digital CCTV camera system an alarm will sound if the equipment is faulty or not recording, thereby alerting management of the need to intervene. The CCTV system will be regularly serviced by qualified maintenance technicians.
 - (iii) Suitable and sufficient warning signs shall be displayed in the public areas of the premises advising that CCTV is in operation at the premises.
 - (iv) CCTV recordings and footage shall be made available for review by the Police upon request (subject to the requirements of the Data Protection legislation in force at the time).
- (2)
 - (i) A 'Staffsafe' system with both audio and visual monitoring capabilities will be installed in the premises.
 - (ii) The 'Staffsafe' system can be activated by either fixed or mobile panic buttons. Once activated the system links the premises to an external monitoring centre, capable of intervening to resolve the issue and/or provide the premises with appropriate advice or instruction to support and protect any staff member or customer in the premises.
 - (iii) Managers working at the premises will receive safety and security training; including Maybo SIA accredited conflict management training.
- (3) Customers shall not be permitted into the premises with any open vessels containing alcohol.
- (4) Regular litter patrols will be carried out around the premises.
- (5) All external doors at the premises will operate on a self-closing system.
