**Annex 1 – Mandatory conditions**

- (1) Where, at any specified time(s), one or more individuals must be at the premises to carry out a security activity (within the meaning of the Private Security Industry Act 2001), each individual must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority (SIA).

**Annex 2 – Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule**

- (1) Late night refreshment shall not be provided except during permitted hours.
- (2) No charge shall be made for or in connection with the entertainment of persons in the premises during permitted hours, whether for the supply of food or drink, for admission, for service of any description or for any other matter, except any reasonable charge for the use of cloakroom or toilet facilities, unless:-
  - (i) a tariff of charges made in the premises is, during permitted hours, kept displayed in such position and such a manner that it can be conveniently read by persons frequenting the premises and can be so read by any such person before entering; and
  - (ii) the charge is specified for the matter in question in the tariff or is less than a charge so specified.
- (3) Seeking to obtain custom for the premises by means of personal solicitation shall not be permitted outside or in the vicinity of the premises.
- (4) Prominent, clear and legible notices must be displayed at all exits requesting patrons and staff to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and area quietly.
- (5) The area within the immediate vicinity of the premises shall be cleared of litter, including waste arising from smoking activities on a regular basis and always at the close of business each day.

**Annex 3 – Conditions attached after a hearing by the licensing authority**

- (1) No customer orders shall be accepted in the last fifteen minutes permitted for the provision of late night refreshment.
- (2)
  - (i) A suitable and sufficient CCTV system which includes a recording facility must be in operation at all times on the premises when licensable activity is taking place.
  - (ii) The system must retain recording for a minimum of 28 days and these recordings must be accessible by at least one member of staff on the premises at all times who is competent and capable of copying the footage of these recordings upon the immediate request of the Police, Fire Service or officers of the Licensing Authority.
  - (iii) All cameras should, as far as is reasonably practicable, be maintained in good working order. A daily check will be made of the CCTV system prior to the opening of the premises and the results entered into the incident log. Any faults found in the system must be rectified by 23:00 hours the same day or licensable activity must not take place.
  - (iv) Suitable and sufficient CCTV cameras shall be located so as to ensure all internal public areas and the area directly outside the front of the premises are monitored.
- (3) A minimum of one SIA licensed door supervisor will be on duty and operational at the premises from 01:00 hours until the close of the premises on any day when licensable activities take place after 01:00 hours.
- (4) An incident log must be maintained at the premises detailing all accidents and incidents of crime and disorder. This log must be signed each day by the person in charge of the premises, be retained for at least six months and be made available upon the immediate request of the Police or Licensing Authority.
