- (1)
 - (i) A suitable CCTV camera system linked to a suitable recording facility must be in operation at the premises during permitted hours and be sufficient so as to promote the prevention of crime and disorder both within and in the immediate vicinity of the premises.
 - (ii) So far as is reasonably practicable, the CCTV system must be maintained in good working order at all times.
 - (iii) CCTV recordings and footage must be retained for a minimum period of 7 (seven) days and be made available for review by the Police or Licensing Authority upon request
- (2) The extract ventilation system(s) serving the premises shall be of such construction, design and otherwise be suitably maintained so as to ensure no noise emissions are created that are capable of causing noise nuisance to adjacent residential properties.
- (3) Prominent, clear and legible notices shall be displayed at all exits of the premises, requesting patrons and staff to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and area quietly.
- (4) The area in the immediate vicinity of the premises shall be cleared of litter on a regular basis and always at the close of business
