Annex 2 – Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

- (1) No licensable activities shall be undertaken except during permitted hours.
- (2)
 - (i) A suitable a sufficient alarm system, meeting a minimum standard of BSEN50131 grade one, shall be installed and operational at the premises. This shall be kept in good working order.
 - (ii) The system shall include a panic button for staff usage at the public counter of the premises.
- (3) A minimum of two (2) staff, trained in accordance with the conditions of the licence must be in attendance at the premises between the hours of 22:00pm and the close of business on any day.
- (4) Further to condition (1) of Annex 3 below, any CCTV system at the premises shall have suitable a sufficient cameras positioned in such a way as to enable recording of a frontal head and shoulders image of every person entering the premises.
- (5)
 - (i) Suitable and sufficient interior and exterior lighting shall illuminate the premises.
 - (ii) All lighting shall be of such design and construction so as to discourage crime and disorder, support the CCTV system and comply with condition (6) of Annex 3 below.
- (6)
 - (i) Suitable and sufficient ventilation and extraction systems shall be installed, operational and maintained in good working order at the premises.
 - (ii) Any ventilation and extraction system shall be of such design and construction so as to prevent noxious smells causing nuisance to other properties within the vicinity of the premises
- (7) Suitable and sufficient information, instruction and training shall be given to all staff employed at the premises on the steps necessary to protect any child(ren) from harm to a level commensurate with their role and responsibilities.

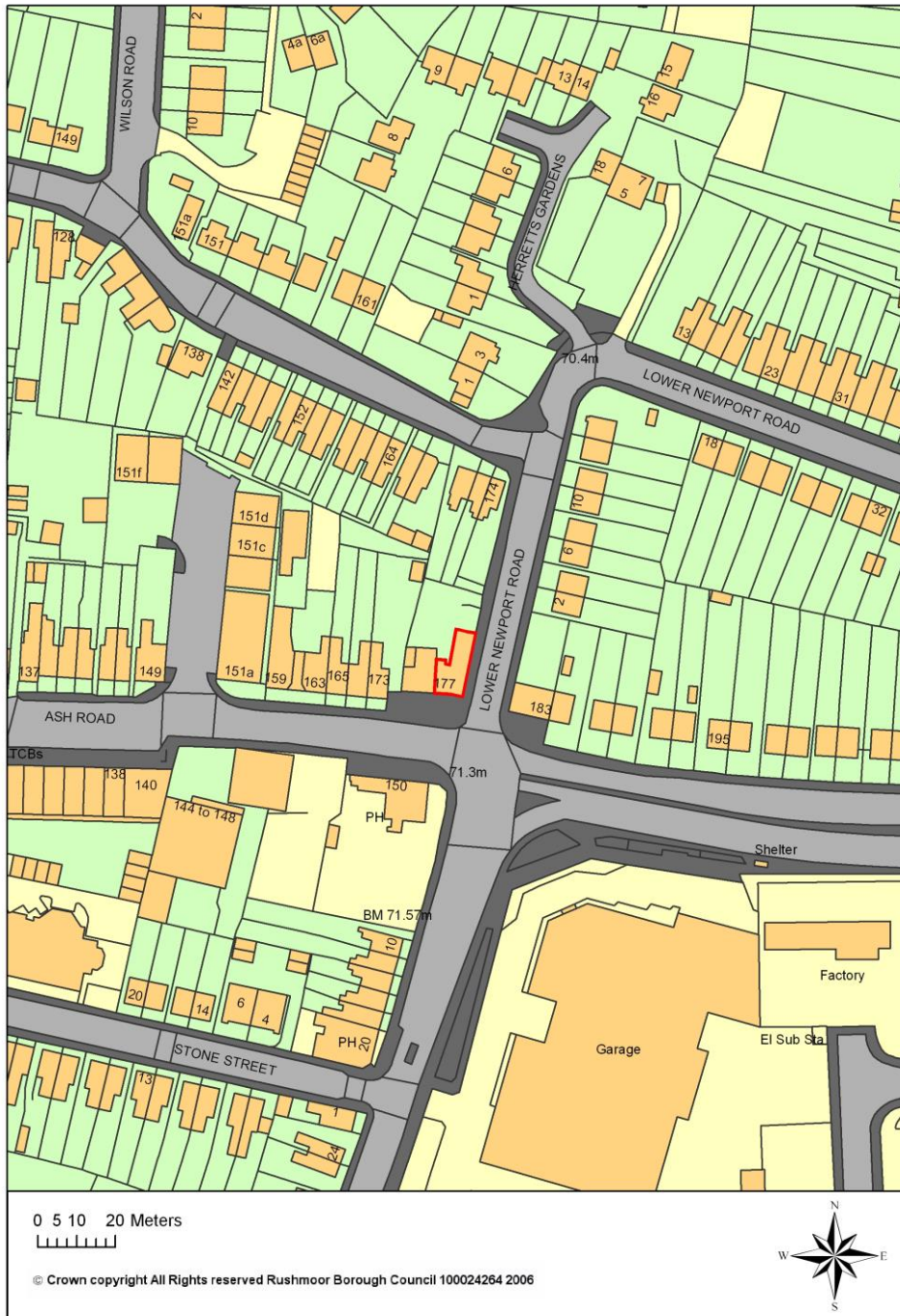
Annex 3 – Conditions attached after a hearing by the licensing authority

- (1)
 - (i) A suitable and sufficient CCTV camera system linked to a suitable recording facility shall, so far as is reasonably practicable, be operational at the premises during any period in which licensable activities are permitted.
 - (ii) So far as is reasonably practicable, the CCTV system must be maintained in good working order at all times.
 - (iii) CCTV recordings and footage must be retained for a minimum period of 31 (thirty-one) days and be made available for review by the Police or Licensing Authority upon request.
 - (iv) All CCTV recorded images and footage and copies thereof shall, so far as is reasonably practicable, be of evidential standard / quality and otherwise be regarded as identification standard.
 - (v) All CCTV recorded images / footage and copies thereof shall, so far as is reasonably practicable, display the correct time and date of each recording.
 - (vi) The CCTV system shall be capable of producing immediate recordings on site and a person conversant with the operation and retrieval of information obtained by the CCTV system shall be available to attend the premises at all times.
- (2)
 - (i) A suitable and sufficient list of contact details of emergency services shall be readily available on the premises at all times.
 - (ii) All staff shall be made aware of the emergency contact list and trained and instructed to call the appropriate emergency service in the event of incidents of crime and disorder or public nuisance.
- (3) The area within the immediate vicinity of the premises shall be cleared of litter, including waste arising from smoking activities on a regular basis and always at the close of business each day.
- (4)
 - (i) A suitable and sufficient number of receptacles for waste arising from smoking activities shall be provided at the exit(s) from the premises.
 - (ii) All litterbins and, where provided, receptacles for waste arising from smoking activities shall be kept clean and be emptied daily.

- (5) A suitable and sufficient number of prominent, clear and legible notices must be displayed on the premises requesting patrons to dispose of litter responsibly.
- (6) All lighting, including external lighting and lights activated by sensors, shall be correctly adjusted so that it only illuminates the surface(s) intended and does not unreasonably throw light onto neighbouring property.
- (7)
 - (i) Prominent, clear and legible notices must be displayed at all exits requesting patrons and staff to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and area quietly.
 - (ii) So far as is reasonably practicable, staff shall verbally reiterate the requirement for customers to leave the premises and surrounding area quietly when they leave the premises.
- (8) No licensable activities or the consumption of food or drink shall be permitted in any external area(s) of the premises used by customers / patrons between 23:00pm and the end of specified opening hours on any day. Only smoking may be permitted in any authorised external area(s) of the premises during the time stated.
- (9) Except for access and egress, all external doors and windows must be closed and kept closed between 23:00pm and the end of the specified opening hours on any day.
- (10) Suitable and sufficient plastic cones shall be placed on the forecourt of the premises so as to prevent any vehicles parking there from 23:00 until close of business.
- (11) Food shall not be consumed by members of the public on the premises at any time.
- (12) All staff / employees shall be made aware of the conditions attached to this licence through a mechanism in writing.
